About:

Kennesaw State University's Bagwell College of Education, School of Art and Design and Bernard A. Zuckerman Museum of Art have joined to create two high-profile Youth Art Galleries on the University campus. Set to debut in October 2016, the galleries will be located in Kennesaw Hall and the new Chantal and Tommy Bagwell Education Building. Each location will have 30 ready-made frames, and will serve as inspiration for KSU students, faculty members, and visitors alike. The exhibitions will be rotated three times a year. Spring and fall rotations are to highlight KSU student teachers and alumni. The summer rotation will be open to any Georgia teacher. Inclusion in any block is competitive and will be determined by the KSU stakeholders.

- A one-page lesson plan (including grade level, number of students, goals, objectives)
 - The lesson plan will become part of the display and must follow the format provided.
 - Where applicable, rationale for instances where the 30 pieces include multiple lessons
- Sample of the student's work or the sample you will use for instruction (as a pdf or jpeg)

Deadlines:

September 15th for consideration of October displays.

February 15th for consideration of March displays.

April 15th for consideration of June displays.

Exhibition duration:

October - March

March - June

June – October

Artwork and display requirements:

- The artwork must be two-dimensional and fit into a ready-made frame.
 - The artwork cannot exceed 16 x 12 inches maximum (or 12 x 16 inches).
 - Smaller artwork is welcome.
 - Multiples can be clipped together, so the pieces get matted and framed together.
- Kennesaw Hall frames are a *landscape* orientation (16 x 20 inches) whereas the Bagwell Building frames are *portrait* style (20 x 16 inches).
 - *Please indicate which gallery the submission is for on the Submission form.*
- The submitting teacher must be prepared to fill all 30 frames of one gallery.
- A teacher may apply for both galleries in one exhibition block, but may only achieve one display at the discretion of the selection committee.

Teachers selected for display are responsible for transporting work to and from the Zuckerman Museum of Art, % Katy Malone, Outreach and Education Coordinator, at least two weeks before and two weeks after the display. Each artwork must have an individual copy of the *Artwork Label Form* on attached to the back (keep a copy of each of the Label Forms for your records!). Please point the arrow toward the top of the artwork to ensure proper orientation. The Museum and its partners will mat and put the artwork into the frames. Upon its return to the teacher, the artwork will retain the mat.

Teachers selected for display will receive:

- 30 printed invitation note cards for parents and family members.
- Additional copies of the card can be produced by the teacher from a digital version.
- Each show will have a free opening reception with light refreshments.
- The reception will be advertised through a digital invitation that is sent to all stakeholders and the teacher for further distribution.

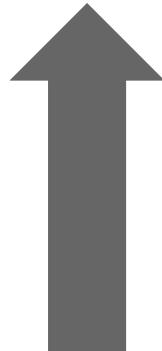
